Creativity: In 2001 we created www.abcdvbbs.net, now the largest source of information for Chinese students studying in Germany. We created the Chinese term for Au Pair 互惠生 (Hù Hù Shēng), now we help Chinese au pairs go overseas and overseas 互惠生 come to China. Our innovation continues on a wide variety of programs.

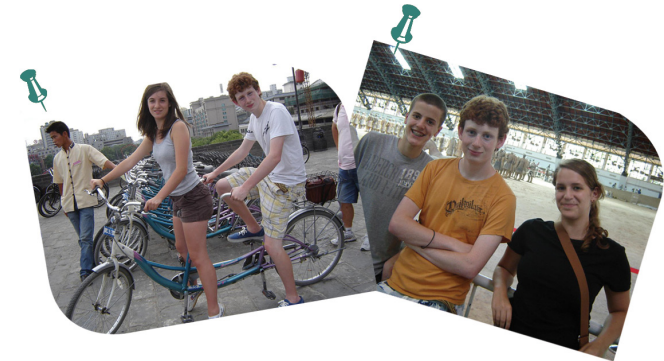
Inbound Programs

China Au Pair Program (CAP)

Participants can learn Chinese and experience local culture by living as a member of a Chinese family. Our Au Pairs earn pocket money as well as free room and board during their stay, in exchange for taking care of children and teaching them English.

China Internship Program (CIP)

CIP is designed for university students and recent graduates to broaden their horizons and gain valuable professional experience by being exposed to Chinese culture and the country's dynamic business world.

China Volunteer Program (CVP)

Volunteers in this program get the opportunity to make profound contributions to China's society and environment, through educational and environmental preservation projects. As well as the difference volunteers can make, they also get the opportunity to gain better understanding of Chinese people and culture.
